STREETSQUASH HIGH SCHOOL COLLEGE ACCESS AND SUCCESS PROGRAM

Working with the StreetSquash Academic, Squash and Social Work departments, the College Access & Success Program helps our students prepare for their post-secondary education. Students participate in:

- Weekly College Prep sessions for all high school students
- College exposure: college visits, college admissions presentations, and an annual college fair
- Individualized, free ACT Prep courses
- One-on-one college application and financial aid counseling
- Family workshops and advising on college applications and financial aid
- Annual events focusing on college and career exposure

COLLEGE SUCCESS AND ALUMNI SUPPORT PROGRAM

- Six-week Beginning College Program prepares rising college freshmen with skills and resources to facilitate successful academic and social adjustments for college transition.
- At least one college campus visit freshman year and one college visit between second year and graduation
- Regular communication, postcards and care packages sent home and to dorms
- Two professional development workshops/networking events each year for all alumni
- First Year Success monthly meetings for New York City commuter alumni
- Two annual alumni squash tournaments, including the National Urban Squash and Education Association (NUSEA) Alumni Cup
- Weekly Alumni Squash Nights
- Attendance based scholarship for all graduates
- Additional internship stipends and scholarships available for students with outstanding participation in the StreetSquash College Success Program and the StreetSquash community

STATISTICS

- 100 percent of StreetSquash students graduate from high school. Of that number, 94 percent on average continue to matriculate to a two-year or four-year college in the fall.
- Total number of StreetSquash Alumni currently in a post-secondary program: 74
- 70 percent of those in the College Success Program achieve an associate's or bachelor's degree, complete a certification program, or join military service within 6 years.
- Total number of graduates from a post-secondary program: 62
