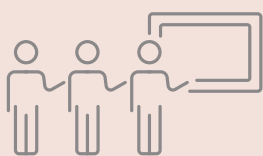

BY EXPOSING STUDENTS TO A BROAD RANGE OF EXPERIENCES AND BY MAINTAINING THE HIGHEST STANDARDS, STREETSQUASH HELPS ALL PARTICIPANTS REALIZE THEIR ACADEMIC, ATHLETIC, AND PERSONAL POTENTIAL.



ACADEMICS

Academic sessions at StreetSquash focus on homework help, development of study skills and consistent work habits, and individualized academic support for each participant. In 2022, the Academic Department implemented a new learning platform called IXL which provides over 8500 skill based lessons across 5 subjects: ELA, Math, Science, Social Studies & Spanish. Each student received an individualized learning plan to help close equity based learning gaps that were exacerbated by the pandemic.

CASAS

The College Access, Success & Alumni Support Program, a core component of the After School Program, creates pathways to college and post secondary programs for StreetSquash's high school participants and provides them with college counseling and support services through college graduation and beyond.

CASAS begins in 9th grade for all StreetSquash students. The program provides intensive support and guidance throughout all stages of the college admissions process, helping build awareness in the early stages, so that students have the opportunity to attend a college or a post secondary program that fits their educational, financial and personal needs.

The College Success & Alumni Support Program is focused on supporting StreetSquash students through their post-secondary education and connecting them with educational and professional opportunities after completing high school. The program begins even before students are accepted into college, through career panels, mock interviews, and resume workshops.

CAREER DEVELOPMENT

The StreetSquash CASAS team conducts two assessments with high school and college students during the school year: the Myers Briggs Type Indicator (MBTI) and the Strong Interest Inventory Profile and Interpretive Report. Based on the results of these assessments, StreetSquash provides individual career counseling with students which includes:

SUMMER

When the final school bell rings for the year, StreetSquash provides summer programming for students. Summer Discovery and Summer Quest are camps for both middle school and high school participants.

In 2022, StreetSquash provided 7.5 hours of daily academic enrichment, social emotional learning, swimming instruction, and squash instruction between July 5th and August 12th. A total of 64 participants were involved in StreetSquash's summer camp. StreetSquash also helped 12 individuals gain entry into the workforce as part of New York City's Summer Youth Employment Program.

Each Friday, students enjoyed a field trip to various places in and around New York City including the Modern Museum of Art, Rise NY, an escape room and Rye Playland.
